CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Mr. VIEW COUNTRY CLUB

of John Day , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mt. View Country Club Well a tributary of John Day River - Main F rk for the purpose of irrigation of 33.6 acres

under Permit No. G-553 of the State Engineer, and said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, at the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 1, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 SW2, Section 21, T. 13 S., R. 31 R., W.M. Well is 950 ft. N. & 675 ft. E. from S.W. corper Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres Swi Swi 1.2 acres SEI Swi Section 21 6.8 acres NEI NWI 18.0 acres NWI NWI Section 28 5.6 acres NEI NEI Section 29 T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
