## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That LAKESHORE GARDENS DRAINAGE DISTRICT

of Lakeshure Road, Klamath Falls , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Upper Klamath Lake a tributary of for the purpose of irrigation of 73.4 acres

under Permit No. 4861 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 23, 1919 for 0.35 cubic foot per second, April 23, 1920 for 0.08 c.f.s., and August 13, 1920 for 0.49 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.92 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 10 (SE‡ NW4), Section 25, T. 38 S., R. 8 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

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conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.8 acres Lot 11 (SW4 NE4)
2.0 acres Lot 12 (SE4 NE4)
2.6 acres SE2 NE4
6.5 acres Lot 10 (SE4 NW4)
1.8 acres Lot 8 (NE4 SW4)
5.2 acres Lot 3 (NE4 SW4)
23.1 acres Lot 6 (NE4 SE4)
26.0 acres Lot 7 (NW4 SE4)
1.4 acres Lot 4 (NW4 SE4)
Section 25
T. 38 S., R. 8 E., W.M.

The land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows:

Those parts of Lakeshore Gardens lying north of Market Rd. (Now Rocky Point Rd.)

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
