CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RAY NELSON

of 34 S. River Rd., Cottage Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon of a right to the use of the waters of Coast Fork Willamette River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of

irrigation of 1.3 acres and operation of a ram under Permit No. 23266 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 23, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.016 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.014 c.f.s. for ram,

or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Small DLC 57, Section 32, T. 20 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Ram and 1.3 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Small DLC 57 Section 32 T. 20 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is 163.2 ft. S. of the NW corner of County Survey No. 185, said corner being marked by a stone 24" X 10" X 6", run thence S. 126.0 ft., thence E. 511.5 ft. to the center of the channel of the Coast Fork River, run thence down the center of said river channel 128.6 ft., run thence S. 89° 24' W. 511.5 ft. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of

ORS 537.290
