CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That P. C. CURTIS

of Cove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well a tributary of Warm Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 1.5 acres

under Permit No. G-1098 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 29, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 3S., R. 40E., W.M. Well is 853 ft. N. and 312 ft. E. from S.W. corner Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 15
T. 3S., R. 40E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Commencing at a point 44 rods North of the Southwest corner of Section 15; thence running East 20 rods; thence North 16 rods; thence West 20 rods; thence South 16 Rods to place of beginning. Excepting a tract of land in the Northwest corner thereof conveyed to the Methodist Episcopal Church of Cove, Oregon, described as follows: beginning 60 rods North of the Southwest corner said Section 15 and running thence East 60 feet; thence South 45 feet; thence West 60 feet; thence North 45 feet to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
