**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That J. G. GALLABER**

of 716 N.E. "A" St., Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Five Finger Creek and Myrtle Creek a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of mining

under Permit No. 21561 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 27, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second, being 0.3 c.f.s. from Five Finger Creek and 0.2 c.f.s. from Myrtle Creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, T. 37 S., R. 9 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Claim is located by a stake upon which this notice appears; said stake being located at the point where Myrtle Creek empties into the Illinois River. I claim 800 ft. down stream and 520 up stream from this point. By Metes and bounds description: beginning at location stake at Mouth of Myrtle Creek, thence down stream 800 ft. to stake No. 3., thence 1320 ft. S. Easterly to stake No. 4, thence 660 ft. S. Westerly to stake No. 5, thence N. Westerly 1320 ft. to stake No. 6, thence 330 ft. N. Easterly to lower end center stake. This is in Section 21, R. 9 W., T. 37 S., W.M., Josephine County, Oregon—and will be known as the Myrtle Creek Placer Claim.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
