## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That HERBERT R. STRONG

of Rt. 1, Box 516, West Linn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River a tributary of Willamette River

irrigation of 1.6 acres

for the purpose of

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 23267 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 17, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Swit NET, as projected within Athey DIC 73, Section 28, T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 1.6 acres SWI NET as projected within Athey DLC 73 Section 28 T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at an iron pipe which is 918.49 ft. South 0° 39' East from the Northeast corner of the James Athey DLC; thence South 78° West 981.83 ft. to an iron pipe set on the left bank of the Tualatin River; thence tracing the high water mark of the Tualatin River up stream North 43° 52' West 217.25 ft. to an iron pipe; thence continuing tracing the high water mark of the Tualatin River up stream North 39° 58' West 67.5 ft. to an iron pipe; thence leaving the Tualatin River and running North 78° 15' East 1046.9 ft. to the center of a 60foot County Road; thence tracing the center of said County Road South easterly 202.06 ft. thence South 0° 39' West 65.14 ft. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
