under Permit No. 26706 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 19, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW SW, Section 13, T. 6 N., R. 2 W., W.H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic NW4 SW4 Section 13 T. 6 N., R. 2 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point 24° South of the SE corner of the Sg of the NWg of the SW of Section 13, T. 6 N., R. 2 W., W.M., Columbia County, Oregon, running thence West 134°, thence North 150°, thence East 134°, thence South 150° to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
