CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That E. H. TAYLOR

of Rt. 2, Bcx 285, Central Point , State of Oregon , has made rroof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River and Drain Nos. 1 & 2, and Slough

a tributary of Rogue River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 17.4 acres and supplemental irrigation of 25.2 acres

under Permit No. 23678 of the State Ar jineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 3, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for sail purposes, and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic foot per second, being 0.06 c.f.s. from Rogue, 0.12 c.f.s. from Drain 1, and 0.11 c.f.s. from Drain 2, and 0.24 c.f.s. from Slough

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NE4 and Lot 7 (SW4 NE4), Section 15,

T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per-acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 42 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Primary 6.2 acres 11.2 acres

NW4 NE4 Lot 7 (SW4 NE4) Section 15 T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
