CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That JOSEPH C. TAYLOR AND ROSA TAYLOR

of Olene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of springs on bank of Lost River, a tributary of Lost River

domestic use, for the purpose of the irrigation of 143 acres of land, and

under Permit No. 1618 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 368, on the 17th day of November, 1920; that the priority of

the right hereby confirmed dates from May 3, 1913; that the amount of

water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 1.84 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 35 acres in Lot Nine; 19 acres in Lot Eight; 14 acres in Lot Seven; 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 8 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Thirty-nine South, Range Ten, and 7 acres in Lot Ten of Section Nineteen, Township Thirty-nine South, Range Eleven and one-half, All East of Willamette Meridian, in Klamath County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation, the use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
