CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That R. V. MARTIN

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean

for the purpose of the irrigation of 65 acres of land and the development of 16 theoretical horsepower, utilizing a fall of 5 feet

under Permit No. 1732 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 368, on the 17th day of November, 1920; that the priority of

the right hereby confirmed dates from June 6, 1913; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 28.19 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 48 acres in Lot Three (S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and 17 acres in Lot Four (W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty, Township Thirty-six South, Range Four West of Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for power. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
