**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify,** That **WALTER H. & BESSIE L. WELCH**

of Route 1, Box 124, Cornelius, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream & Welch's Pond const. under Appl. #R-29436, Per. #R-1672 a tributary of East Dairy Creek for the purpose of irrigation and stock

under Permit No. 23175 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 30, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.131 cubic foot per second; being 0.13 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.001 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 15, T. 2 N., R. 3 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1672,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and stock  
Section 15  
T. 2 N., R. 3 W., W.M.

This certificate is issued to correct and supersede that certain water right certificate issued to Walter H. and Bessie L. Welch on March 18, 1960, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 19, Page 26768, so as to correctly locate the lands irrigated.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
