This Is to Certify, That ALBERT NELSON

of Rt. 2, Box 12, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Hopkins Gulch and unnamed gulch, tributary of Stearling Creek, appropriated under Application No. 24785, Permit No. 19669 for irrigation,

for the purposes of

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1058 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 31, 1950

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 6.5 acre feet, being 3.8 acre feet in Hopkins Gulch Reservoir, and 2.7 acre feet in Unnamed Gulch Reservoir

The reservoir is located in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 38 S., R. 2 W., W.M.
