The Dalles Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the Fifteen Mile Creek Eight Mile Creek a tributar waters of , for the purpose of the irrigation of 73-5/8 acres of land under Permit No. 2715 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume , on the 17th day of November, 1920 at page ; thut the priority of the right hereby confirmed dutes from November 15, 1915 : that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not cubic feet per second., or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to, any reasonable, rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is us follows: 10 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwestquarter; 182 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 15-1/8 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Eleven and 15 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twelve, Township One South, hange Thirteen East of

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the linds or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
