CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED DAVIS AND TRESA DAVIS

, has made proof Echo , State of Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells for the purpose of a tributary of Butter Creek (Umatilla River)

irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 120 acres

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. G-438 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 21, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.50 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the #1 SW NE , #2 NE NW, Section 19, T. 3 N., R. 28 E. W.M.

Well #1 is 1800 ft. S. and 2550 ft. E. from NW corner 19.

Well #2 is 1230 ft. S. and 1250 ft. E. from NW corner 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of cach year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 20.0 acres NEt NWt 38.4 acres SET NWT 21.8 acres NW NE 39.8 acres SW NE Section 19 T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
