CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIS A. and ANNA R. SCOTT

of Route 2, Box 29 Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 80 acres

under Permit No. 4538 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 14, 1918

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 39 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 7.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 40.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 27.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 30
 T. 39 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Certificate of water right issued on July 1, 1926 to J. C. and Gillie Cass and recorded at page 6317, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates confirms a right to the use of 2 cubic feet per second of the waters of Little Applegate River for the irrigation of 80 acres and the development of 11 theoretical horsepower with a date of priority of March 14, 1918, said right to the use of water for the development of power being limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right.

This certificate issued to Willis A. and Anna R. Scott and recorded at page 28525, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate heretofore issued to J. C. and Gillie Cass and recorded at page 6317, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to eliminate the right to the use of water for the development of power.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
