## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That HAROLD STILLER

of Route 1, Box 132 Milton-Freewater, State of Cregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 39.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. C-1114 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 25, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE2 NR2, Section 25, T. 6 N., R. 35 N., W.M.

Well: 985 ft. S. and 25 ft. W. from NK corner SE2 NR2, Section 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to "cne-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
