This Is to Certify, That JACKSON COUNTY

of Jackson County Courthouse, Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of three wells

a tributary of Jackson Creek (Bear Creek) irrigation of 81.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-843 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 15, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.02 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Wells #1 & #2. NE NE Section 28; Sump SW SE SE Section 21, all as projected within Welton DLC 67. T. 37 S., R. 2 W., W.M. Well #1 is 3530 ft. S. & 350 ft. E. #2 is 3683 ft. S. & 350 ft. E., Sump is 2075 ft. S., & 20 it The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
