exceed 0.75 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 5 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Six South, kange Three West of Willamette Meridian, in Polk County, Oregon.

The location of the works for power purposes are in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Six South, kange Three West of Willamette Meridian, in Polk County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated or its equivalent in case of rotation balance by the proper tatle of the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of farty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
