CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIE C. MCGOVERN

of 1801 Echo Hollow Rd., Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Sparks Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-30222, Permit No. R-1769 a tributary of McKenzie River for the purpose of maintenance of log ponds, fire protection and sawmill

under Permit No. 23735 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 27, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for fire protection and sawmill, and 0.07 c.f.s. for maintenance of pond,

or its equivalent in ~~rotation~~ rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located to the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 16 S., R. 4 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Log Pond, Sawmill

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
