## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

## This Is to Certify, That HAROLD BARNETT

of 103 N. E. Ellis Pendleton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Hollow

a tributary of Wild Horse irrigation of 12.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23114 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the INT SW1, NET SW1, SET SW1, SW1 SE1, Sec. 21, T. 3 N., R. 35 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.3 scres NE3 SN4
0.8 scre NN3 SN4
4.2 scres SE4 SN4
4.7 scres SN4 SE4

T. 3 N., R. 35 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
