that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second, being 0.1 c.f.s. for pond and 0.03 c.f.s. for boilers,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW1 ME1 SE1 NE1, Section 31, T. 14 S., R. 16 E., W.M.; One well is 29 chains South and 192 chains West, one well is 26 chains South and 302 chains West, both from NE corner, Section 31.
