CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **FRANK H. JACOBSEN**

of **1432 N.W. Keasey Rd., Roseburg**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Newton Creek**

a tributary of **S. Umpqua River** for the purpose of
irrigation of 2.5 acres and use in poultry buildings

under Permit No. **26392** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **October 12, 1959**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.04 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for use in poultry buildings**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Lehnhart DIC 52, Section 14, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to a period when the flow in the S. Umpqua River is 60 c.f.s. or more at its mouth,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 stock & 1.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 1.0 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 as projected within **Lehnhart DIC 52**
Section 14
T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the S. E. corner of Lot 2, Umpqua Fruit Ranch Tracts, from which the quarter corner between Section 11&14, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W.M., bears N. 6° 7' W. 1257.1 ft.; thence S. 00° 45' E. 86.0 ft. to creek and the Northeast corner of the Chester E. Vance, et ux, property; thence following up the creek as follows: South 89° 56' W. 90.2 ft.; thence S. 51° 48' W. 139.6 ft.; thence S. 85° 32' W. 171.7 ft.; thence S. 47° 23' W. 116.2 ft.; thence N. 63° 32' W. 159.0 ft. to the E. line of the property of Camillo di Domenico; thence North 1° 26' W. 216.0 ft. to the South line of said Lot 2, Umpqua Fruit Ranch; thence along the South line of said Lot 2 S. 88° 28' E. 611.4 ft. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
