CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Thomas Seigel

of Richland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Daly Creek for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 440; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1862 for Tract No. 1 and 1882 for Tract No. 2

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-twentieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1 - 28.0 ac. in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 18.0 ac. in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 10.5 ac. in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, 4.0 ac. in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 31, T. 9 S., R. 46 E., W.M.

Tract No. 2 - 40.0 ac. in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 30, T. 9 S., R. 46 E., W.M.

Note: 87 acres of the above lands have a supplemental supply from Eagle Creek under priority of 1901 through the Howell Ditch.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
