**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** CLARENCE S. GUSTINE

of 845 Lebanite Dr., Lebanon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Holly Acres Well

a tributary of S. Santiam River (Willamette River) for the purpose of irrigation of 6.0 acres

under Permit No. G-476 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 4, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Richmond Cheadle DLC 38, Section 19, T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; Well is 240° S. & 2365° W., from N. E. corner of Richmond Cheadle DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
3.9 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
as projected within Cheadle DLC 38  
Section 19  
T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

0.2 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
as projected within Cheadle DLC 79  
Section 24  
T. 12 S., R. 2 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8" bolt on the North line of and N. 89° 55' W. (N. 89° 47' 30" W. by some surveys) 2,103.5 feet from the Northeast corner of the Richmond Cheadle D. L. C. 38 designated as Claim #38 in T. 12 S., R. 1 W.; and D. L. C. #69 in T. 12 S., R. 2 W. of the W. M. in Linn County, Oregon; thence N. 89° 55' W. 493.05 feet along said D. L. C. line a spike; thence S. 0° 05' W. 416.0 feet to a spring leaf; thence N. 89° 55' W. 114.0 feet; thence S. 0° 05' W. 92.72 feet to a spring leaf; thence S. 89° 55' E., parallel with the North line of aforesaid D. L. C. 606.92 feet to a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " angle iron; thence N. 0° 06' E. 508.72 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6 acres, more or less, excepting and reserving therefrom to the grantors herein a strip of land 20 feet in width along the East boundary of said premises to be granted to the public for a public roadway.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
