or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE1 NE2, as projected within Geo. Force DIC 37, Section 4, T. 1 N., R. 1 E., W.M.; Well is S. 75° W. 650 ft. from N. E. corner, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: \cdot
