## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That PAUL E. PEMBERTON

of 12314 S. E. Holgate, Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Johnson Creek (Willamette River) irrigation of 0.9 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-1063 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 21, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.01** cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (No. 1 No. 1 No.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightisth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre Lot 6 (NW4 NW4) Section 14 T. 1 S., R. 2 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

A part of Government Lot six (6) of Section 14, T. 1 S., R. 2 E., W.M., Multnomah County, Oregon, described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Section 14; thence North 89° 40° E. along the N. line of said Section 14, 272.83 ft. thence S. 0° 31° E. 25 ft. to an iron pipe at the true point of beginning of the tract to be described; running thence S. 0° 31° E. 400 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 89° 40° E. 100 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 0° 31° W. 400 ft. to the S. line of S. E. Holgate Blvd. thence S. 89° 40° W. 100 ft. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
