irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1729 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 8, 1954

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-said, shall not exceed 28.0 acre feet

The reservoir is located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W.M.
