CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JAMES J. & AUGUSTA P. PAGE

of 13470 S.W. Far Vista St., Beaverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Beavardam Drainageway

a tributary of Cedar Mill Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 0.5 acres

under Permit No. 24059 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 11, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within L. Hall DLC 43, Section 4, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within L. Hall DLC 43
Section 4
T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the County Road #215 from which the most northeasterly reentrant corner of the W. boundary line of the Lawrence Hall DLC 43 bears N. 64° 24' E. a distance of 30.47 ft. to an iron pipe set in the northeasterly side line of said county road; thence S. 35° 43' E. tracing the northeasterly side of said county road a distance of 423.66 ft. to an iron pipe; thence N. 66° 07' E. a distance of 1278.13 ft. to an angle point; thence N. 65° 43' E. 57.58 ft. to an iron pipe and the true point of beginning of the tract to be conveyed; thence N. 24° 46' W. a distance of 203.9 ft. to an iron pipe; thence 65° 14' E. 106.94 ft. to an iron pipe; thence S. 24° 46' E. a distance of 204.09 ft.; thence S. 65° 43' W. 106.95 ft. to the true place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
