CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EVAN & ERNEL C. LARSON

of Rt. 1, Box 82, Lebanon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Santism River

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 3.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23788 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 18, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.04** cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NE4, as projected within Keesa DLC 53, Section 29, T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres SE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4} as projected within Keese DIC 53
Section 29
T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of and S. 89° 41° E. 64.753 chains
from the Northwest corner of the Elnore Keese DLC 53, in T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W.M.,
in Linn County, Oregon; and running thence S. 0° 10° W. 24.006 chains to a 5/8"
bolt; thence N. 42° 48° E. (old bearing N. 42° E.) 3.632 chains to a 5/8" rod;
thence N. 0° 10° E. 17.843 chains to the Northerly bank of the Scuth Santism River;
thence N. 35° W. along said bank 4.271 chains to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
