of Lyons , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unmamed spring stream, unnamed stream & reservoir, to be constructed under Application No. R-29869, Permit No. R-2552 a tributary of Trask Creek (N. Santiam River) for the purpose of manufacturing and maintenance of log ponds

under Permit No 27017 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 1, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic foot per second, being 0.38 c.f.s. from unnamed spring stream and reservoir for manufacturing and 0.10 c.f.s. from unnamed stream to maintain log ponds constructed under Permit Nos. R-924 and R-947

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the spring stream [E] SE4, Section 19, unnamed stream SE4 SE4, Section 19, T. 9 S., E. 2 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ————— of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
