## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

for the purpose of

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 0-354 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 10, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWA SWA as projected within St. Pauls Catholic Mission DLC 75, Section 19, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Well is N. 85° 21' E. 68.11 chs. from S.W. corner, DLC 75, T. 4 S., R. 2 W.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second peracre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
