**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** ROLAND P. SHEPARD

of Rt. 1, Box 938, Prineville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of McKay Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 11.3 acres

under Permit No. G-1039 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 28, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T. 14 S., R. 15 E., W.M. Well is 815 ft. South and 1540 ft. E., from NW corner, Section 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 25  
T. 14 S., R. 15 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Commencing at a point 1320 feet East, thence 115 feet South to the place of beginning from the Northwest corner of Section 25, township 14 South of Range 15 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence East 250 feet; thence South 27 degrees East 850 feet, thence South 53 degrees West 693 feet; thence North 37 degrees West 157 feet; thence North 1045 feet, more or less to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
