## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That Oregon STATE GAME COMMISSION

of 1634 S. W. Alder Street, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bull Creek

a tributary of North Umpqus River for the purpose of maintenance of Whistlers Bend reservoir constructed under Application R-34267, Permit R-2469 for fish culture

under Permit No. 26966 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 22, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **2.0 cubic feet per second** 

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre, the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the N. Umpqua River is 525 cubic feet per second or more attite mouth,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
