CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **HOWARD H. HENRY**

of **245 N. 24th Springfield**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Big Fall Creek** a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of irrigation of **20.6 acres**

under Permit No. **26304** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 4, 1959**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.22 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Stewart DLC 37, Section 33, T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W.M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eighth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet** per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**2.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
13.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.2 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
5.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within **Stewart DLC 37**
Section 33
T. 18 S., R. 1 W., W.M.**

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of the West half of the John Stewart DLC 37 in T. 18 S., R. 1 W., of the Willamette Meridian, where the low water mark on the North side of Little Fall Creek intersects the same; thence South 1768.0 feet more or less to the Southeast corner of the West half of said DLC 37, thence West 700 feet to the center line of Big Fall Creek; thence down the center line of Big Fall Creek North 24° West 500.0 feet, and about North 10° East 1320.0 feet to the mouth of Little Fall Creek, thence Easterly along the low water mark on the North bank of said Little Fall Creek to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
