## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHESTER W. SPENCER &amp; J. W. MILLER

of Trail, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Elk Creek, a tributary of Rogue River  
for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per  
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

1.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 17,  
T. 33 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

J. W. Miller, or successor in interest  
9.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$

## Note:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 19, 1960 pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. W. Miller and recorded at page 15848, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
