CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ARTHUR GALBREATH

of Route 4, Sherwood, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Cummins Ditch and Unnamed Ditches
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.0875 c.f.s.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

7.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at an iron
in the center line of County Road No. 505 S. 88° 59' W. 2851.1 feet and S.
16° 28' E. 253.1 feet from the quarter corner on the east line of Section
21, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; thence S. 16° 28' E. 673.9 feet to the inter-
section with center line of Cummins Ditch; thence westerly following said
ditch 1446 feet to a point (witness corner on south bank of ditch); thence
north 948 feet more or less to a stake; thence N. 88° 59' E. 1173 feet to
the point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
