## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY GALBREATH

of Route 4, Sherwood, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Unnamed ditches trib. to Rock Creek  
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1625 c.f.s.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

0.1 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
12.9 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 28  
T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at a point  
S. 89° 31' W. 1250.1 feet and S. 0° 28' E. 155.8 feet from the north quarter  
corner of Section 28, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.; thence S. 34° W. 1050 feet to  
a point; thence west 400 feet more or less to the west line of claimant's  
land; thence north 850 feet more or less to the northwest corner of claimant's  
land; thence N. 89° 31' E. 1000 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
