CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARY, JOHN AND ERWIN GALBREATH
as tenants in common

of Route 4, Sherwood, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Unnamed springs & ditches trib. to Rock Creek

for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1312 c.f.s.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
5.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at a point on the south line of Section 21, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M., 1000 feet S. 89° 01' from the south quarter corner of said Section 21; thence S. 89° 01' W. 564.5 feet to an iron; thence north 874.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 89° 01' E. 446.82 feet to a stake; thence south 487.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 89° 01' E. 400 feet to a point; thence S. 35° W. 450 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
