and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2262 c.f.s.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

O.l acre in SWASWA
Section 4
1.4 acres in SEASEA
Section 5
13.4 acres in NEANEA
Section 8

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at a point on the section line between Sections 4 and 5, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W.M. 150 feet north of the corner common to Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, running thence east 250 feet to a point; thence south 850 feet more or less to the south line of the Arthur Burris DLC #42; thence west along said south DLC line to the section line between Sections 8 and 9 and continuing along the projection of said south DLC line, 950 feet to a point; thence north 700 feet more or less to a point on the south line of Section 5; thence N. 81° 15° E. 960 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
