CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. H. JOOS

of 152 N. 10th Street, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Unnamed Creek trib. to McKay Cr.

for the purpose of Stock Drinking directly from the source, and is limited not to exceed 20 head.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 38 of said Decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
 The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
