CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON IRON & STEEL CO.
By: Paul T. Murphy, President
of Oswego, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Tualatin River
for the purpose of Development of 934 Theoretical Horse Power

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from July 25, 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 57.5 c.f.s. diverted
from the Tualatin River into Oswego Lake through the Oswego Canal.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

NE 1/4 Section 10
T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
