for the purpose of Irrigation and Stock Drinking directly from the source, and is limited not to exceed 30 head.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Washington County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 419; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.050 c.f.s. for Irrigation and shall be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 58 of said Decree for Stock Drinking.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

4.0 acres in SWISEL Section 22 T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west line of the SWLSEL, Section 22, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W.M. 11.5 chains north of the SW corner of said SWLSEL; thence N. 72° E. 4.5 chains more or less to a point being the point of beginning of the tract here described; thence continuing N. 72° E. 14.5 chains to a point; thence S. 6° E. 5.5 chains; thence S. 72° W. 15.2 chains to a point; thence north 5.8 chains more or less to the point of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
