## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certifu, That MARGRETHA KIME , Stute of Harper Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Malheur River , a tributary of Snake River , for the purpose of the irrigation of 20.15 acres of land Permit No. 3583 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume November, 1920; that the priority of on the 17th day of at page the right hereby confirmed dutes from November 12, 1917 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount netually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall confirm to carry, reasonable categories, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 7.70 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 12.45 acres in the Southwast quarter of Northeast Twenty-seven, Township Twenty South, Range Forty-one Fast of Willamette Meridian, in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
