CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That AUGUST WEINKE of Pilot Rock, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Birch Creek, a tributary of the Umatilla River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 25 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 127; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1895

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic feet per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree and all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 13 1/2 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 11 1/2 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-seven, Township One North, Range Thirty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

(NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct and supercede that certain certificate issued to Geo. V. Runyan on December 29, 1919 and recorded in State Record of Water Right certificates, volume 3 page 2614 and in Volume "A" page 361 Book of Water Right Certificates for Umatilla County, wherein the land was erroneously described as 13 1/2 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and 11 1/2 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, T 1 N. R. 32 E. W. M.)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
