CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GERHARD ROGGE

of Idleyd Rt. Box 264, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 25203 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 26, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Trask DLC 40, Section 14, T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one~~-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Trask DLC 40
Section 14,
T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a 3/4" iron rod at the intersection of an Easterly R/W line of Co. Rd. No. 4 and the Northerly r/w line of the North Umpqua Hwy., from which the corner to Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24 bears S. 78° 02' E. 3540.6 ft.; thence N. 89° 27' E. 630.0 ft. along the Northerly R/W line of said North Umpqua Hwy. to a 3/4" iron rod; thence N. 0° 10' 30" W. 542.1 ft. to a 3/4" iron rod in a Southerly R/W line of aforesaid Co. Rd. No. 4, thence S. 57° 47' W. 151.9 ft. and S. 88° 35' W. 415.1 ft. along said Southerly R/W line. Thence along an Easterly R/W line, around a curve, the long chord of which bears S. 42° 13' 30" W. 129.0 ft.; thence S. 0° 12' 30" E. 361.6 ft. along said Easterly R/W line to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
