CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That MRS. S. P. ALLYN

of Oak Grove, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River, a tributary of Deschutes River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 50 acres of land

under Enlargement Permit No. 108 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 280, on the 9th day of March, 1918; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 6, 1911; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.63 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 20 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Eight, Township Seventeen South, Range Twenty-two East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

(NOTE: This certificate is issued pursuant to decision and order of the State Water Board dated February 26, 1921, in the case of Roy Morris, v. Mrs. S.P. Glenn-Allyn, which said order cancels that certain certificate issued to Mrs. S.P. Glenn-Allyn March 26, 1918, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Vol. 3, Page 1996, and requires this certificate to be issued to supersede the former, for the purpose of reducing the acreage under the right, from 70 acres to 50 acres.)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
