CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWARD HINES LUMBER CO., Dee Division

of P.O. Box 210, Hood River, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of East Fork Hood River
for the purpose of fish ladder and leakage

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 200; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from September, 1905;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 13 cubic feet per second
for fish ladder and leakage.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of use:

T. 1 N., R. 10 E., W.M.

Certificate of water right issued to Oregon Lumber Co. and recorded at page
15008, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to
the use of water for power, fish ladder and leakage. Subsequently, the right to
the use of 284.5 cubic feet per second for the development of power was canceled
and the right to the use of 37.5 cubic feet per second for the development of
power was transferred to other uses by order of the State Engineer entered
January 31, 1962, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530 and 543.730.
This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for
fish ladder and leakage and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Oregon
Lumber Co.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
