**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That MAUD L. JACKSON**

of **Scottsburg**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of **Umpqua River** for the purpose of irrigation of not to exceed **1/2 acre lawn and garden and domestic use for one family**

under Permit No. **25774** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 31, 1958**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 8 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 5, T. 22S., R. 9 W., W.M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right to the use of water for irrigation is limited to the period when the flow of water in the Umpqua River is **525.0 cubic feet per second or more at its mouth,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Domestic**  
**SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$**   
 as projected within Spicer DLC 39  
 Section 8  
 T. 22S., R. 9 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
