CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VIRGIL and KAY BERRY

of Williams, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Clapboard Gulch, tributary of East Fork Williams Creek, appropriated under Application No. 30120, Permit No. 23772,

for the purposes of

irrigation
 under Reservoir Permit No. R-1782 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 7, 1955

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 7.0 acre feet

The reservoir is located in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Davidson DLC 37, Section 10, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.
 Diversion point from Clapboard Gulch is in Lot 4 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 10, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

NOTE:

This certificate is issued to correct and supersede that certain water right certificate issued to Virgil and Kay Berry on November 10, 1961, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 21, Page 29130, so as to correctly locate the point of diversion from Clapboard Gulch.
