CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

for the purpose of the irrigation of 106 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Vallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 148; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to un amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed lig acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 20 acres in the $NW_4^1NW_4^1$; 6 acres in the $SW_4^1NW_4^1$; 24 acres in the $NF_4^1SW_4^1$; 36 acres in the $NW_4^1SW_4^1$; and 20 acres in the $SF_4^1NW_4^1$ of Section 11, Township 1 South, Range 43 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
